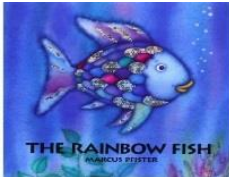


Session 7 Empathy

Colour mixing A nice way to experiment with colour mixing is to paint each of your child's hands in a different colour and watch what happens when your child's hands are rubbed together. Which new colour have they made?

Exploring the effects of mixing cornflour and water. Try this at home. What happens when you add more / less cornflour?
