



Rosie's Walk

Next week we will be...

Learning the sounds e, l, h and r

Each day, ask your child about the sound that they have learned and practise it with them. Ask your child if they can think of a word that starts with that sound.

Counting forwards and backwards to 20 (and beyond).
Identifying 2D shapes and making shape pictures with them.

Point out 2D shapes in their environment, eg. The shape of the clock is a circle

Practise identifying **numerals** to 10 (and beyond) with your child.



Reading 'Rosie's Walk' and sequencing the events.

Talk to your child about friendships – who are your friends? What makes a good friend?
