Home Learning

This week the children will be lists for shopping and following instructions for cooking.

Encourage your child to write lists at home – on paper or on the computer.

The children will be encouraged to use their sounds to write a simple/compound sentence.

Encourage writing – have felt pens, pencils, crayons and paper available.

The children will be estimating the number of objects in groups.

Play estimation games with objects to encourage a realistic understanding of quantity..

The children will using an 'addition machine' to solve simple addition problems.

You could make an 'addition machine' at home with your child using recyclable materials.
