**Y4 visit to The Natural history Museum
Thursday 18th May 2017**

As part of the children's studies in Science, we have arranged for Year 4 to visit The Natural History Museum on Thursday, 18th May 2017. They will get an opportunity to walk around the museum looking at a vast range of specimens from various segments of natural history. We have also arranged for them to participate in a 'Cutting Edge' workshop which costs £3 per child. This is an interactive workshop to investigate how teeth are related to diet which links in with our Science topic this term.

We will depart from school promptly at 9:00 am and travel to the museum by a privately rented coach. The children will require a packed lunch for the day (no glass bottles please) which should be carried in a named string bag or rucksack so the children's hands are free. We will return to school by 3.15 pm for normal home-time arrangements. The children will need to wear full school uniform.
