Last week our 'Star of the Week' was




Ralph

### Making their own treasure box!

The children will be making their own treasure boxes this week. We will be talking to children about things that are treasures to them. We would love the children to bring in a small treasure in a box this week. We will encourage them to talk about what they have brought in. Asking questions such as why is your treasure so special? Where did you get it? Who gave it to you? Where do you keep it?

### Making a healthy salad.

Maybe you can make something healthy at home and take a picture of it. The children could then stick it in their special books and talk about what they made.

### Weighing pirate treasure

If you have a weighing scales at home, maybe you could weigh a variety of objects and talk about which one is heavier or lighter.

If you do not have a traditional balance scales, the children can pretend to be weighing scales with their arms out stretched. Place two objects in their hands and ask which one is heavier. Demonstrate to show that your arms will go down if the object is heavy.
