# The Curriculum

- Maths – Place Value, Addition and Subtraction, Multiplication and Division, Shape, Angles, Fractions, Measurement (length, weight, money, time, perimeter volume and capacity).
- English (reading) – Guided Reading and Whole Class Shared Reading: develop fluency, expression, comprehension, inference, identifying themes.
- English (writing) – Punctuation, Grammar, Plan, Draft, Edit: through Narrative/Story Writing, Information Texts, Poetry, Instruction Texts, Diary Entry, Newspaper Report, Persuasive Letters and Play Scripts

# The Curriculum

- Science – Plants, Animals, Rocks, Light, Forces & Magnets
- History – Stone Age, Roman Empire and Anglo Saxons.
- Geography – Locate world countries with a focus on Europe, Human and Physical Geography, Develop skills in using maps, globes and compasses.
- Computing – Productivity, Programming, Creativity, Communication, Computational Thinking.
- Art – related to one of above topics.
