Mathematician of the term:

Greek mathematician Euclid is often referred to as the 'Father of Geometry' for his revolutionary ideas and influential textbook called 'Elements' that he wrote around the year 300 BC.



What we are learning this term:

Year 1: Place value, addition, subtraction and shape.

Year 2: Place value, addition, subtraction, money, multiplication and division.

Year 3: Place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division.

Year 4: Place value, addition, subtraction, length, perimeter, multiplication and division.

Year 5: Place value, addition, subtraction, statistics, multiplication, division, perimeter and area.

Year 6: Place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions, position and direction.
